2009 Six-a-Side Tournament Rules

1. Normal F.A. Laws apply during the tournament with the following exceptions:
 - a. No offside Law.
 - b. The initial start of the game will commence with a kick-off decided by a toss of the coin as is normal.
2. For U7, U8, U9 and U10, all goal kicks will be taken from the line on the respective side of the goal. All other age groups the goalkeeper must throw the ball **underarm** at all times from anywhere within the penalty area.
3. The semi-circle will denote the penalty area. U7's to U10's penalties will be taken from the spot. U11's to U14's penalties taken from the edge of the 10m area.
4. Players cannot score direct from kick-off.
5. Age groups for the 2007/2008 season will apply. Players can play up in age groups but not down. In the event of any dispute clubs will be required to provide evidence of age. The fielding of over-age players will be reported to Surrey FA.
6. For age groups U7s to U10s, A squad will be a maximum of **Ten** players, **SIX** of whom will form the team, with one player being the goalkeeper.
7. For age groups U11s to U14s, A squad will be a maximum of **Eight** players, **SIX** of whom will form the team, with one player being the goalkeeper.
8. Substitutes may be rolled on and rolled off during each game without restriction.
9. Correct size match balls shall be provided by Bookham Colts for each match as follows:
 - o Size 3 for Under 7s and Under 8s
 - o Size 4 for all other age groups.
10. A player cannot play for more than one team in the tournament.
11. Any player sent-off by the referee, or cautioned twice during the tournament, shall take no further part in the competition.
12. In the event of a clash of team colours, the first-named team shall change. (The tournament organizers will provide coloured bibs and be available from the registration/scoreboard area.
13. No linesmen are required.
14. All referees shall be appointed by the tournament organisers.
15. League games shall be of **SIX minutes** duration each way.
16. League winners shall be decided by:
 - a. First points
 - b. Then goal difference
 - c. Then, by the team having scored the most goals.In the event of the result still being undecided, five penalties will be taken by each side and then sudden death.
17. There shall be TWO points awarded for a win, and ONE point for a draw.
18. Within each age group, the winners of the two leagues will play each other for the Winners Cup and the runners up of the two leagues will play each other for the Plate. These matches will be of **EIGHT minutes** duration each way.
In the event of a draw at the end of normal time, FOUR minutes of extra time will be played, each way.
In the event of the result still being undecided, goalkeepers will be withdrawn and the GOLDEN GOAL wins the match.
19. **Ungentlemanly behaviour by club officials, supporters or players may render the respective team liable for disqualification.**
20. In the event that a team is withdrawn or disqualified midway through the tournament, all matches played or not played against that team shall be recorded as a 0-0 draw
21. No smoking is allowed inside the grounds
22. No dogs are allowed inside the grounds
23. The taking of photos and video of the matches **are** permitted.
24. The following awards are to be presented:
U7s & U8s: A football for each team's leading scorer and another for each teams player of the tournament will be given to each team registration for the team managers to award to their players.
U9s to U14s: Winners – Medals + Winners Cup - Runners Up – Runners Up Cup - Third Place – Plate
